

Rice County Fair Special 4-H Awards

BEEF-DIVISION A

MARKET STEERS AND HEIFERS

Awards will be given for Angus, Hereford, Shorthorn, Crossbred, AOB Steer, Market Heifers, All Breeds.

Champion and Reserve Champion will be chosen in each class. A Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion market beef over all classes will be chosen.

BREEDING BEEF

Awards will be given for Heifer Calf, Junior Yearling, Summer Yearling, Senior Yearling, Cow.

Breeding classes will be shown by breeds. Champion and Reserve Champion will be chosen in each breed.

Showmanship, 7-10 years old, Showmanship, 11-13 years old, Showmanship, 14 years and older. Age as of January 1st of current year.

Showmanship judging will be based on 40% fitting and 60% showing. Animals shown in showmanship must identified in the 4-H'ers name.

BUCKET CALF- DIVISION AA

CLASSES: Bucket Calf- 7-9 years old, Bucket Calf- 10-12 years old, 2nd Year Bucket Calf

DAIRY-DIVISION B

CLASSES: Calf, Yearling Heifer, Cow. Classes will be shown by breed. Champion and Reserve Champion will be selected in each breed according to general rules.

Showmanship, 7-10 years old, Showmanship, 11-13 years old, Showmanship, 14 years and older. Age as of January 1st of current year.

Showmanship judging will be based on 40% fitting and 60% showing. Boys and girls must show an animal they own in showmanship class.

DAIRY GOATS-DIVISION BB

CLASSES: Junior Doe, birth and under 4 months, Junior Doe, 4 months and under 8 months (not in milk and previously freshened), Junior Doe, 8 months and under 12 months (not in milk and not previously freshened), Senior Doe, 24 months and older (in milk or previously freshened), Showmanship, 7-10 years old, Showmanship, 11-13 years old, Showmanship, 14 years and older. Age as of January 1st of current year.

Showmanship judging will be based on 40% fitting and 60% showing. Boys and girls must show an animal they own in showmanship class.

SWINE-DIVISION C

MARKET SWINE

Awards will be given for Market Swine. Champion and Reserve

Champion will be chosen in each weight class. A Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will be named.

Showmanship, 7-10 years old. Showmanship, 11-13 years old. Showmanship, 14 years and older. Age as of January 1st of current year,

Showmanship judging will be based on 40% fitting and 60% showing.

SHEEP-DIVISION D

MARKET LAMB

Awards will be given for Market Lamb.

Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will be named.

BREEDING PHASES

CLASSES: Breeding Ewe Lamb, Breeding Ewe.

Breeding classes will be shown by breeds. Champion and Reserve Champion will be chosen in each breed.

Showmanship, 7-10 years old, Showmanship, 11-13 years old, Showmanship, 14 years and older. Age as of January 1st of current year.

Showmanship judging will be based on 40% fitting and 60% showing.

MEAT GOATS-DIVISION DD

CLASSES: Market Meat Goat Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will be named.

BREEDING PHASES: Junior Doe never freshened: Doe less than 6 months of age, Doe 6 months to 1 year, Doe over 1 year.

Senior Doe pregnant or have previously freshened: Doe up to 24 months, Doe 24 months and older.

A Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will be named.

Showmanship, 7-10 years old, Showmanship, 11-13 years old, Showmanship, 14 years and older. Age as of January 1st of current year.

Showmanship judging will be based on 40% fitting and 60% showing.

ROUND ROBIN SHOWMANSHIP CONTEST

The top 2 overall showmen in each species are eligible for the Round Robin Showmanship Contest-two showman per species (possible 14 4-H'ers total); 7 species (2 animals per species-14 total animals). Superintendents are asked to notify kids and round up 4-H'ers to fill all slots. If a 4-H'er places first or second in more than one specie, the child chooses which specie to show and the superintendent goes down the line to fill that slot. All showmen are equal when the event starts. A reserve could win it all or even a third or fourth place child could possibly win it all.

HORSE-DIVISION E

LUNGE, SHOWMANSHIP, HALTER

Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Halter (1st and 2nd from each class may compete for Grand Champion and Reserve Champion)

DOG SHOW-DIVISION F

SHOWMANSHIP- Pre-Junior Showmanship, 7-9 years old, Junior Showmanship, 10-11 years old, Intermediate Showmanship, 12-14 years old, Senior Showmanship, over 15 years old.

OBEDIENCE- Pre-Novice A-Beginner dog & handler, Pre-Novice B- One is beginner & one is experienced, Novice obedience, Graduate Novice Obedience, Open B Obedience, Utility A Obedience, Utility B Obedience.

AGILITY COMPETITION-Agility I., Agility II.

Champion may be awarded in each class. Reserve Champion ribbon may be awarded in each class.

POLTRY-DIVISION G

CLASSES: Standard breeds, pen, Standard breeds, pullet, Standard breeds, cockerel, Cross-breeds and in-breeds (3pullets), Cross-breeds and in-breeds, pullet, Cross-breeds and in-breeds, cockerels, Production hens (for those who have kept egg records beginning September 1. Egg records must accompany exhibits),Capon, all breeds. Pen-3 birds, 1 breed, Capon, single entry, Bantams, all standard breeds. Pen-2 pullets, 1 cockerel,Bantam, single entry, Turkey, all breeds. Pen-2 of 1 breed, Turkey, hen, Turkey, Tom, Ducks, all breeds. Pen-2 of 1 breed, Ducks, all breeds. Single entry, Geese, all breeds. Pen-2 of 1 breed, Geese, hen, Geese, gander, Other poultry. Single entry, Pigeon-old cock (hatched in previous year), Pigeon-old hen, Pigeon-young cock (hatched in this calendar year), Pigeon-young hen.

BROILERS-Pen of 3 birds-9 weeks of age and under, Pen of 3 birds-10 weeks of age and over, Birds should be uniform in size-may be either pullets or cockerels. Pen card should have date hatched and pounds of feed fed.

A Champion and Reserve Champion will be chosen from breeding pen and production pen. A Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will be chosen over all breeds.

RABBITS-DIVISION H

1.CLASSES: Junior Doe (Under 6 months of age and meeting weight requirements for the breed), Intermediate Doe- not all breeds have this class (6-8 months of age and meeting weight requirements for certain breeds of rabbit), Senior Doe- a mature female

rabbit meeting the weight and age requirements for the breed, Junior Buck (under 6 months of age and meeting weight requirements for the breed), Intermediate Buck- not all breeds have this class (6-8 months of age and meeting the weight requirements for certain breeds of rabbit), Senior Buck- a mature male rabbit meeting the weight requirements for the breed., Meat Pen-3 rabbits all one recognized breed and variety; minimum weight 3 pounds each, maximum weight 5 pounds each. Will be judged on their meat qualities, condition and uniformity.

2.CLASSES: Normal White Fur, White Satin Fur, White Rex Fur, White Wool, Normal Colored Fur, Colored Stain Fur, Colored Rex Fur, Colored Wool.

A Champion and Reserve Champion will be named by breeds. A Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will be named overall.

Showmanship, 7-10 years old, Showmanship, 11-13 years old, Showmanship, 14 years and older. A Champion and Reserve Champion will be named.

PETS-DIVISION I

CROPS-DIVISION J

A Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will be chosen over all classes.

CLASSES: White Corn (any variety), Yellow Corn (any variety), Forage sorghum (any variety). Complete stalk, Wheat (any variety), Oats (any variety), Barley (any variety), Alfalfa seed, Alfalfa hay, Grass seed, Grass hay, Soybeans (bundle of 5 variety named), Soybeans (variety named) 1 gallon, Sunflowers Confectionary Heads 93 heads must be submitted), Sunflowers Confectionary Seeds (in jar-1 gallon jar must be submitted), Sunflower Oil Seeds Heads (3 heads), Sunflower Oil Seeds (in jar-1 gallon), 4-H Wheat Variety Booth.

A Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will be chosen over all classes.

HORTICULTURE-DIVISION K

CLASSES: Garden display-exhibit consists of five different fresh vegetables. Display should be exhibited in a tray, basket or container that can be easily moved. Canned vegetables and shelled vegetables are not acceptable. Only one variety of a specific vegetable may be exhibited. The number of the five vegetables may be exhibited. The number of the five vegetables to be exhibited are as follows:

Small Vegetables -12 required-Green Beans, Lima Beans, Peas. Medium Vegetables- 5 each-Beets, Kohlrabi, Parsnips, Potatoes, any color, Sweet potatoes, Carrots, Cucumbers, Okra, Peppers, Onions, Tomatoes, Turnips Large Vegetables-1 each-Cabbage, Pumpkin, Squash, Watermelon, Cantaloupe, Eggplant.
